Carl A. Bongiovanni Vo-Tech Scholarship – 2020 Helping Students in the Construction Trades



Carl A. Bongiovanni was a lifelong resident of Allegheny County, and continuously involved with his community in a number of capacities. He was the owner and president of Bon Tool Company, presently in Gibsonia, PA, from 1994 until his sudden passing on January 26, 2017.

Bon Tool Co. has been a family owned and run business for over 60 years, providing the highest quality tools to professional construction tradesmen. Carl's dedication to the business was matched by his lifelong belief that there is, and always will be, an urgent need to support the many young men and women who choose a career in the technical and labor trades. He was a founding committee member of the VICA/Skills USA's masonry competition.

The Carl A. Bongiovanni Scholarship was made possible by the outpouring of love and donations from his friends and family with the guidance and support of the Pittsburgh North Optimist Foundation (PNOF). The purpose of this scholarship is to provide an individual with funding assistance for continuing their education in the building/construction trades at a post-secondary institution, The scholarship is valued at \$2,000 per year, applied directly to the educational institution, for as long as the student is enrolled and in good standing in his or her program, with a maximum of three years.

The Trades: Individuals looking to further their education in one of the trades listed below are eligible to apply for this scholarship. Other construction related trades may be considered. Carpentry, Construction Management, Construction trades (or similar program), Drywall/Lathing, Electrician, Horticulture, HVAC, Ironworking, Masonry, Plumbing, Welding

Eligibility: The applicant must be a Pennsylvania resident who is looking to continue their education in a post-secondary institution in one of the trades noted above.

Scholarship Selection Process: A review board will evaluate all applications and finalists will be selected for an interview prior to the final selection process. The scholarship will be awarded during the PNOF's award ceremony or some other relevant/function.
